## Printable Christmas Card

Here's a quick Christmas card you can print at home. This Christmas card will fit into most standard envelopes so it's easy to send to your loved ones.

Instructions:

1. Cut out the Christmas card on the broken line.
2. Fold the card on the solid line so that the picture shows on the outside (the card will stand up like a tent with the picture on the front side and your message on the back).
3. Write your message on the card.

\* When the card is folded it will fit into most standard sized envelopes. When it is removed from the envelope, the fold will allow it to stand up and be displayed like other cards.
